Reporting to the Manager, Petroleum Geosciences, the Petroleum Geologist increases the capacity for NWT petroleum geoscience research at the Northwest Territories Geoscience Office (NTGO). The position undertakes geoscientific studies that increase knowledge of the NWT's petroleum resources and encourage development of these resources, resulting in economic benefits to the NWT.

The successful applicant should have knowledge of the geological principles related to sedimentary basin analysis, stratigraphy, sedimentology, tectonics and petroleum systems.

The successful incumbent must also have knowledge of the techniques used in well log analysis; petroleum play development; bedrock and subsurface mapping; analyses of samples in outcrop, core and drill cuttings; and stratigraphic correlation. Familiarity with the principles of seismic interpretation is an asset. Project management, organization and logistical skills to effectively manage and participate in both independent research and integrated geosciences projects.

Typically, the above qualifications would be attained by a Master of Science degree in Geology with a focus on petroleum geology and/or a sedimentary sub-discipline and two (2) years work experience in the petroleum industry, academia or a government geosciences agency in a petroleum-related capacity. Knowledge of the NWT's Phanerozoic stratigraphy would typically come from previous work in the area.
